The social parties constituting the National Employment Council for the Agricultural Industry in Zimbabwe (NECAIZ), which are Timber Producers Association(TPA), Zimbabwe Agricultural Employers Organisation (ZAEO), Zimbabwe Commercial Farmers Union (ZCFU) and Zimbabwe Farm Employers Association (ZFEA) on the employers' side and General Agriculture and Plantation Workers' Union of Zimbabwe (GAPWUZ), Horticulture General Agriculture and Plantation Workers' Union of Zimbabwe (HGAPWUZ) and Zimbabwe Horticulture Agro Industries and General Agriculture Workers Union (ZHAGAWU) on the employees' side, taking cognizance of the minimum wage agreement of 14 March 2025 which took effect on 01 January 2025, have concluded this further agreement regarding Timber Subsector Allowances effective 1st October 2025 as follows:

- Without derogation from any further allowances that may have been or will be agreed upon for the generality of the agricultural industry, this present agreement provides for the minimum allowances payable in the Timber Subsector only.
- 2. The minimum monthly allowances payable to employees in the Zimbabwe Gold (ZWG) shall be determined by converting the indexed United States dollar in the schedule below to the Zimbabwe Gold (ZWG) at the interbank rate prevailing on the twentieth (20th) day of the month due to the employees.

Exemptions

An establishment or employees may apply to the National Employment Council within fourteen days for an exemption or partial exemption/review from paying allowances as set up in the above schedule, stating the reasons why the application should be considered.
